Playground Skills Camp



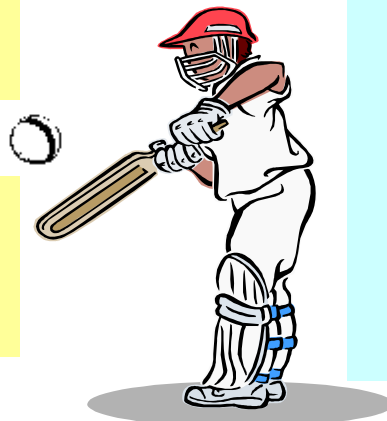
Where?
